Northwest-Shoals Community College wants to help you achieve your academic and career goals. The Dual Enrollment/ Dual Credit Program (DE/DC) allows eligible high school students to earn both high school and college credit. College courses count toward high school graduation credits and the courses remain a part of the student's regular transcript.



Are You Eligible?

Eligible students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a high school sophomore, junior, or senior.
- Have a "B" average in completed high school courses.



To Apply:

- Complete an application for admission.
- Submit your transcript, including ACT scores if applicable.
- Obtain and submit a DE/DC agreement form, completed and signed by your principal and superintendent.
